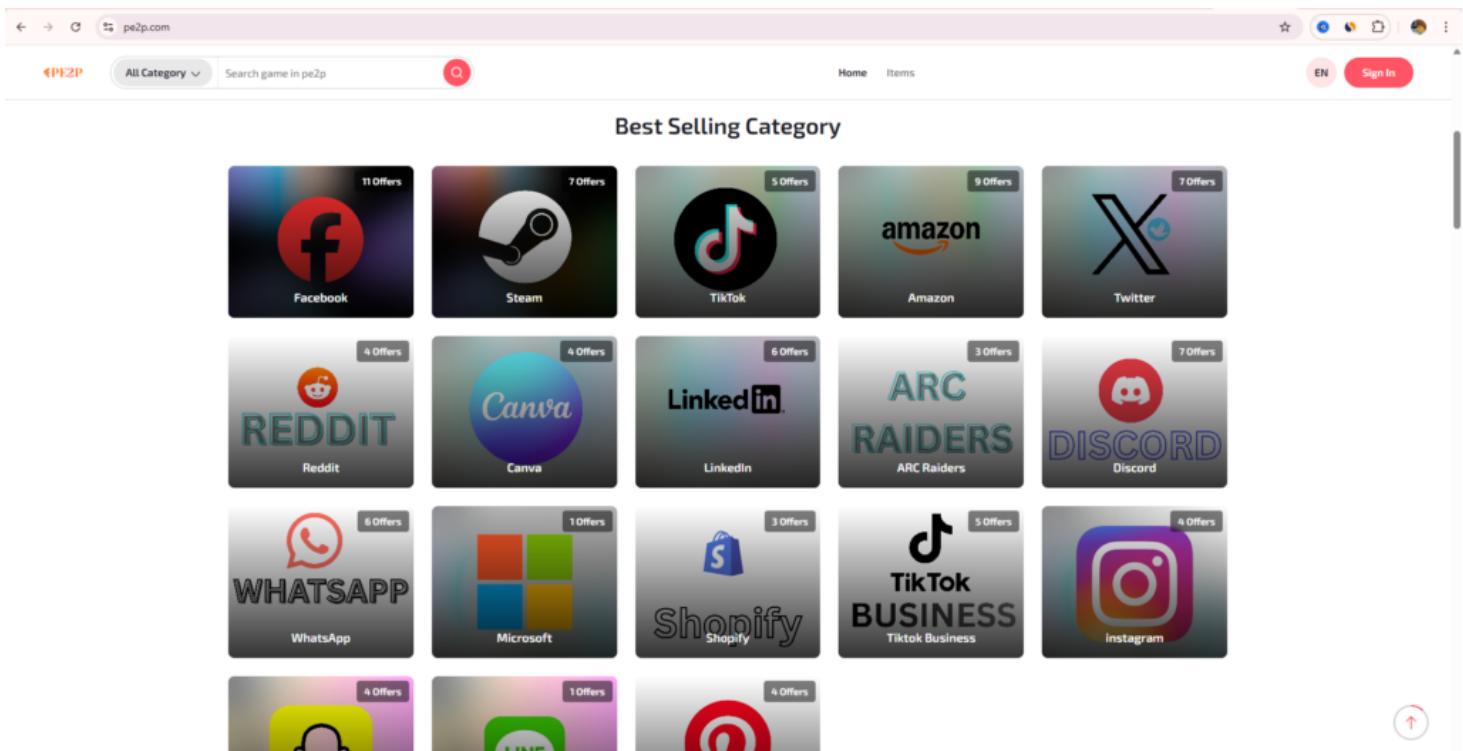

2) FameSwap

FameSwap is different from the other names here because its public identity is much more centered on **social media properties** than on software subscriptions. Its support materials explain how users list social media accounts, follower-based properties, and audience assets, and FameSwap also offers a dedicated escrow service for secure transactions.

That makes FameSwap stronger for buyers who are comparing creator assets, social audiences, or social-property deals, not necessarily software subscription access. In other words, FameSwap is highly relevant in digital asset discussions, but for **Descript subscription buy** intent, it feels less naturally aligned than marketplaces that clearly expose public Descript category pages. Specifically, its rules say invalid accounts may be replaced, and if replacement is not possible, refunds may be available to supported payment systems.

That makes AccsMarket interesting from a buyer-protection-process angle.
